ACS offers free transportation to and from cancer treatment-related appointments through our volunteer driver program



FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN MARION COUNTY

Breast & Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program

All of the following must apply to be eligible: age 50-64; household income at or below 200% of the federal poverty level, uninsured (no insurance or insurance won't pay for mammography, complete breast exam and/or pap smear (including Medicare and Medicaid Part B)); client agrees to complete all recommended diagnostic tests required for cancer diagnosis within 60 days of an abnormal test result; resides in Marion County.

Eligibility exceptions:

Women under the age of 50 may be eligible if: they meet all the above criteria and have a complete breast exam highly suspicious for cancer, (i.e. discrete mass, nipple discharge, skin or nipple changes)

Women ages 65 and older are eligible if: they do not qualify for Medicare but meet all other eligibility criteria.

Women who have insurance may be eligible if: insurance covers only major medical (such as hospitalization) and not preventative wellness services, and meets all other eligibility criteria.

PATIENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Provides limited financial assistance to help meet basic needs (housing, food, utilities, etc.) to those actively in cancer treatment residing in Marion County, FL.

Anyone who is actively in treatment and has a financial crisis/need can apply for assistance by visiting www.hugscharities.info

Applications may be submitted by email or P.O. Box, and are reviewed once a month. Individuals may apply once every 6 months while actively in cancer treatments.

This resource helps meet a major gap/need in our community. HUGs Charities also provides some small grants to local agencies impacting our cancer community through education, prevention, wellness, and screening efforts.
